The Colorado Marriage Project (CMP) was launched in 1998 under the leadership of RMFC. The mission of CMP is to strengthen marriages and reduce divorce in Colorado. CMP focuses its efforts and resources on the faith, business and government communities, encouraging leaders in each community to strengthen marriages.



The goal of this effort is to bring together local religious and community leaders to work on marriage and family issues in their community. It is also focused on the creation of church marriage policies and relevant marriage and family enrichment resources.

Currently, we are a partner with the faith-based Colorado Healthy Marriage Project.

Family Festival:

Back in 1994, it wasn't as trendy as it is today to be patriotic, but RMFC saw the need to offer a family-friendly, non-alcoholic Independence Day celebration in Colorado. Each year since then we have partnered with Bandimere Speedway and COMPA Food Bank Ministry to present the Family Festival.



Nearly 12,000 people make their way into the speedway to watch jet cars, pastor races and pro-points drag racing. The festival has old-fashioned events like pie and watermelon eating contests and an amusement area with over 30 games for kids and adults alike. There are also rides and inflatable games.

The event is capped off with a fireworks display choreographed to patriotic and Christian music. This is the "Premier Event" for Christian families during the Independence holiday.
